GUIDELINES FOR PARTICIPANTS

- 1) Participant's eligibility: Students of 10th, 11th& 12th Standard.
- 2) Advance registration is compulsory for all events. Registration form is attached with the Invitation
- 3) Last date for registration is November 22nd, 2017. **Onetime Registration fees for participants** would be Rs 100/
- 4) Entries received only in prescribed registration form hard copy will be accepted. Entries sent by any other mode will not be considered.
- 5) A student can register for more than one event, depending on the schedule. (Kindly refer the detailed time schedule given in the brochure). If there is clash in the events for which the participant is registered, he/she will be allowed to participate in one event only, and the registration fees will not be refunded.
- 6) Only paid registrations will be considered. Payment is strictly required to be done on or before 22nd November, 2017.
- 7) Spot registration is not allowed for any game.
- 8) Participants are not allowed to change the names of team members in any case.
- 9) Entries are limited and considered on First-come, first-served basis.
- 10) Kindly refer the rules of individual games for team formation. Teams not formed as per mentioned rules will be disqualified.
- 11) All participants have to carry their Institute Identity card.
- 12) One teaching/non-teaching staff should accompany the participating students as a team mentor.
- 13) Change in any rule will be highlighted or communicated before the start of event.
- 14) In case of any discrepancies or disputes, decision of organizing committee will be final and binding to all. In case of all the games, the decision of the judges will remain final.
- 15) Transportation (within Rajkot city) will be provided on prior intimation.

MITTI KE RANG- THE CLAY MODELLING COMPETITION

- 1. Only two entry per Institution is allowed
- 2. Clay will be provided by the host college.
- 3. Theme or topic will be given at the start of the event.
- 4. Model should depict the theme or topic.
- 5. Duration of 2 hours.
- 6. Model should be of 10 inches max.
- 7. Participants can keep cardboard or piece of wood with themselves for the competition.
- 8. No of participants Group of two.
- 9. Each model has to be accompanied with a short write up about the interpretation of the theme.
- 10. The decision of the judges will be final.

GROUP SONG: FOLK (INDIAN)

- 1. Only one entry per Institution is allowed.
- 2. A team has to present a folk song.
- 3. Maximum six singers in group and number of accompanists playing instrument shall be three.
- 4. The group songs should be taken from Indian songs which can be in Gujarati or Hindi language.
- 5. No film song should be presented as group song.
- 6. Maximum time allowed for the group song is 10 minutes.
- 7. The setting time for a group shall not exceed 4 minutes.
- 8. Judging of the item will be on the basic of *quality of singing only* and not on make-up, costumes and action of the team.

SPOT PHOTOGRAPHY

- 1. Only two entry per Institution is allowed
- 2. The participant has to bring his/her own digital camera of not more than 12 mega pixels.
- 3. The digital camera should have a memory card which will be formatted by the judges before the commencement of the contest.
- 4. The time limit will be 2.30 hours.
- 5. The participant has to capture 5 photographs on the theme announced on the spot by the judges.
- 6. No mixing, matching or morphing of photographs will be permitted.
- 7. Software such as Photoshop etc. for enhancing images not permitted.
- 8. The organizers will have all rights for the use of these pictures as and when they deem fit.
- 9. Digital images are evaluated on the basis of (i) impact (ii) composition (iii) technical quality and (iv) suitability for the specific theme.
- 10. The additional instructions will be announced on the spot.

SKIT

- 1. Only one team per institute will be allowed.
- 2. Maximum number of six participants is allowed to participate in this team.
- 3. Maximum time allocated for each team is 10 minutes.
- 4. Use of make-up, drapery and background music is allowed. No personal remarks, aspersions, character assassination etc is allowed.
- 5. Participating team should submit three copies of the synopsis of the theme of skit, along with language of presentation (Gujarati or Hindi or English) on the day of registration.
- 6. The item will be judged basically on the qualities like theme, work on acting, stage craft, design and general impression.
- 7. Only innocent satire or humor is expected. In case a skit is found controversial it would be disqualified.
- 8. The sequence of performance will be decided by drawing lots.

RAAS-GARBA

- 1. Only one entry Institution is allowed.
- 2. Maximum 10 participants allowed per term. The team may consist of all boys, all girls or a mixture of both.
- 3. The number of accompanists permissible is five.
- 4. Live music is not compulsory.
- 5. The dance can only be raas-garba or its variants.
- 6. Duration of dance should not be more than 10 minutes.
- 7. Time for sets/Instruments setting is maximum 5 minutes.
- 8. The sequence of dance will be decided by drawing lots.

T-SHIRT PAINTING

- 1. Only two teams per institute will be allowed.
- 2. Students should bring plain white colour T-shirt for painting.
- 3. Participants can use any decorative things to decorate their t-shirt
- 4. Participants have to carry their own materials
- 5. Time -1 hour

JUNKYARD - BEST OUT OF WASTE

- 1. Only two teams per institute will be allowed.
- 2. A team must consists of a maximum of 3 members
- 3. Materials will be provided by the college.
- 4. Preparation time will be 1 hour
- 5. Team will be given 5 minutes for presentation

BATTLE OF WORDS - THE DEBATE COMPETITION

- 1. Each Institute will be represented by the two debaters; one will speak FOR, while another will speak AGAINST the motion.
- 2. Medium of expression will be Gujarati, Hindi or English.
- 3. Topic of debate will be announced 24 hours in advance.
- 4. Each debater will be allowed to speak for maximum 5 minutes in the Competition.
- 5. The sequence of speakers will be decided by a draw of lots.

MR. BEAN - THE CARTOONING COMPETITION

- 1. Item will be conducted on the spot on the given topic / subject, sheet size 15" * 22".
- 2. Sheet will be provided from organizers.
- 3. Duration will not be more than 2 hours.
- 4. Participants shall bring their own materials required for the contest.
- 5. Topic will be given on the spot.

THE BEST ORATOR - THE ELOCUTION COMPETITION

- 1. Each Institute will be represented by one speaker.
- 2. Medium of expression will be Gujarati, Hindi or English.
- 3. Each speaker will be allowed to speak for maximum 5 minutes.
- 4. Subject/Topic of Elocution will be announced 3 days before.
- 5. The sequence of speakers will be decided by a draw of lots.

CHOWKPURANA - THE RANGOLI COMPETITION

- 1. It is a team event. Each team should consist of two participants.
- 2. Item will be conducted on the spot on the given topic / subject
- 3. Duration will not be more than 2 hours.
- 4. Participants shall bring their own materials required for rangoli.
- 5. Participants may use pulses, pieces powder of wood, petals of flowers etc.
- 6. Size of Rangoli should be 2' * 2'

CORPORATE CHANAKYA – THE BEST MANAGER COMPETITION

(An opportunity to show cast your intellect, skill, technique, courage, creativity, spontaneity, exuberance & passion in the mystic Kurukshetra)

- 1. Each round would have individual marking criteria. Final result would be based upon consolidated marks.
- 2. Judges' decision will be final.
