GUIDELINES FOR PARTICIPANTS

- 1) Participant's eligibility: Pursuing any Under Graduate and Post Graduate course.
 - 2) Registration link is available on www.cimrajkot.edu.in
 - 3) Last date for registration & payment is **16th September, 2019. Onetime Registration Fee for Participants is Rs 150/- (Certificates, Prizes and Awards, Tea, Breakfast, and Lunch)**
 - 4) A student can register in maximum 3 events, depending on the time schedule. (Kindly refer the detailed time schedule given in the brochure). If there is clash in the events for which the participant has registered, he/she will be allowed to participate in one event only, and the registration fees will not be refunded.
 - 5) Spot registration is not allowed for any game. Except Minute to Win-It Game in Entertainment Zone* from 11:30am to 03:00pm
 - 6) Participants are not allowed to change the names of team members in any case.
 - 7) **Entries are limited and considered on First-Come, First-Served Basis.**
 - 8) Kindly refer the rules of individual games for team formation. Teams not formed as per mentioned rules will be disqualified.
 - 9) All participants have to carry their **Institute Identity card**.
 - 10) Change in any rule will be highlighted or communicated before the start of event.
 - 11) In case of any discrepancies or disputes, decision of organizing committee will be final and binding to all. In case of all the games, the decision of the judges will remain final.
 - 12) Transportation (within Rajkot city) will be provided on prior intimation.
 - 13) Accommodation assistance will be provided on prior intimation on the payment basis.

CORPORATE CHANAKYA –THE BEST MANAGER

An opportunity to show case your intellect, skill, technique, courage, creativity, spontaneity, exuberance & passion. The competition will have five rounds. The details of rounds are as follows:

- Round 1: Business Quiz – Part 1: The participants will be asked to appear for a written quiz. The quiz will have 20 questions.
- Round 2: Sherlock Holmes – Games of Reasoning: The participants will be given a case study and 15 questions based on that case study will be asked to test their quantitative aptitude and reasoning skills.
- Round 3: Management Games: The participants will be put in a situation to apply their management knowledge and skills.
- Round 4: Business Quiz (Stage Round): The participants who qualify in the past three rounds will be participating in the stage round of Business Quiz. Stage round will be divided into four sub-rounds to test the business knowledge and general knowledge of final twelve participants.
- Round 5: Penal Interview: Top three participants (based on cumulative scores of past 4 rounds) will be appearing for a panel interview, where they will be judged on the basis of Body Language, Communication, Attitude and General Knowledge.

Note:

- First eliminations will be done after 2nd round on the basis of cumulative score of round 1 and round 2. The total time allocated for round 1 and round 2 will be 30 minutes each.
- Second elimination will be done after round 3 on the basis of scores obtained in round 3.
- Third elimination will be done after round 4 on the basis of cumulative scores of all four rounds.
- For Panel interview the interviewers will be from corporates.
- The decision of jury members will be final and a binding on all.
